

AC FIMEM SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT March to October 2023

A STRONG TIME FOR AC: THE ANNUAL AC FIMEM

The annual AC meeting was held from August 26th to 29th in Paris (France).

After an intense analysis of costs and existing facilities, it was decided that France would be the location of the presential CA meeting. This allowed the participation of the AC FIMEM at the 56th ICEM Congress. The annual AC meeting was facilitated by the generous cooperation of our colleagues Nicolas and Sabine, who offered us their accommodation. Our most sincere thanks to the Paris Freinet group! However, we were unable to have our fellow AC member, Cheikh Mackfousse Seck, present. Despite having sent, many months in advance, all the necessary documentation to obtain his visa (by email and by postal mail), the consulate authorities in Senegal didn't even grant him an interview so that he could present himself nor give explain the reasons for rejection for his trip to France. The AC sent to the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs a physical letter and a message through an online form, pointing out the seriousness of the offense committed in the service of a citizen of Senegal.

Fortunately, during the presential meeting of the AC Cheikh's had a daily participation through videoconferences.

We began the annual meeting of the AC, with a very intense Work Plan and many points to discuss and work on:

RIDEF 2024 and proposals sent by the OC of Mexico; Relations with Movements and communication tools; RIDEF Finance 2022; FIMEM Commissions; Lists and computer tools; Website and Facebook FIMEM Brochure; New FIMEM membership fees, update of the Internal Regulation; Benaiges Scholarship: new edition of the contest, internal regulation of it, jury; Biennials/Convergences.

One of the first tasks, on August 27th, was to hold an online meeting with the OC of Mexico, in which the project presented by the OC and also the planned budget received a very favorable reception. There were exciting exchanges and we are all looking forward to receiving all the information.

At this meeting we dedicated special time to the necessary measures so that Ridefians from Africa and America can obtain their visas on time. The AC asked the OC to publicize RIDEF 2024 through all possible virtual ways. The deadlines for transferring the FIMEM loan to the OC were discussed, the AC is waiting for the OC to give the go-ahead to make the transfer.

During the Annual we take time to talk and reflect together on the issues that involve us all as members of a Federation that brings together people from different cultures, countries with very different socioeconomic situations and different political contexts. With the aim of making a contribution and promoting the debate, we cooperatively wrote a text with these reflections that will be published on the web site and sent to all movements with our reflections about cultural diversities.



NEXT RIDEF IN MEXICO 2024:

The AC sent its secretary, Gabriella Varaldi, on a mission to represent us during the in-person meeting with the organizing committee of RIDEF 2024, which took place in Mexico City and Oaxaca City, from April 29th to May 2nd .

On this occasion, the place where RIDEF 2024 will be held was visited and important meetings were held with RIDEF organizers and local authorities and it was possible to exchange ideas and cooperate.



On May 1st, a virtual meeting was held between AC and OC in which the Mexican working committees were presented. The AC also knew the groups in the city of Oaxaca that will participate in the effort to carry out the RIDEF.

The AC FIMEM thanks the Mexican colleagues for receiving an AC member and congratulates the OC for the intense work they are doing.

UPDATE MOVEMENT DATA AND EMAIL LISTS

The AC sent a data update form to all movements. We thank those who sent us updated data and we hope that those who have not responded to us, we ask that you complete the data as quickly as possible. An exhaustive information survey was carried out among FIMEM members who participate in the mailing lists and these lists are also being updated.



COMMISSIONS

Currently, FIMEM has 14 Committees with a member of the AC as responsible for each of them.

Each AC member as responsible seeks to unite the participants and follow up on the proposals made in the committees.

We invite all members of FIMEM to participate in the commissions that constitute an important instrument to expand the democratic participation of all in the dissemination and development of Freinet Pedagogy.

We highlight the important work carried out by COMMISSION 5 – STATUTES OF FIMEM, which prepares the proposal to modify our Statutes. All this work will be presented to the Movement's delegates in meetings that will be called at the beginning of 2024 by the AC.

RIDEF 2022 AGADIR FINANCIAL COMMITTEE

The AC FIMEM continued its work with the RIDEF 2022 FINANCES committee. Meetings were held between the AC and the treasurers of the implicated movements and auditors. Periodic information was sent to the Movements.

The treasurers of the movements of those who have been accused of some of their RIDEF 2022 tax payments will present official documents (receipts, bank deposits, etc.)

The auditors carried out detailed work verifying all the documentation presented, respecting the ethical principles of confidentiality. On the other hand, AMEM has not presented any documentation regarding the accusations formulated by it.

The auditors wrote a report in which they gave a favorable opinion on the evidence presented and stated that they found no basis for the accusations made by the AMEM.

Despite the conclusive opinion of the Account Commissioners, AMEM continued sending accusatory correspondence and publishing intimidating messages against members of FIMEM.

The AC has responded to these letters and considers all questions regarding payment for registrations for RIDEF 2022 closed.

The AMEM made deposits in the FIMEM account: one for an amount of 5,000 (five thousand) euros and another for an amount of 4,473 (four thousand, seventy and three) euros in concept of return of the RIDEF loan of 10,000 (diez thousand) euros granted by FIMEM in 2022.

However, CA FIMEM is waiting for AMEM to present evidence that the donation has been transferred to the S.O.S Village Children Institution of Maroc and also present evidence that the computer deliberately broken has been repaired.

AC ACTIONS TO SUPPORT MOVEMENTS AND SCHOOLS



In support of the AMALAKA school, which faces threats of having its area, an environmental reserve, divided by a road, the CA wrote a letter to the President of Colombia and other Colombian authorities, requesting a review of the project in question. A communication about this problem was also sent to all movements, encouraging everyone to participate in doing so.

Furthermore, letters were sent by mail to the Colombian Ministry of Transport and the Ministry of Environment, requesting urgent action against threats to the AMALAKA school.



BIENAL/ CONVERGENCES FOR NEW EDUCATION

The AC salutes and thanks the important and sustained work of Agnès Joyeux and Léonard de Leo, who assume the mandate to represent the FIMEM in the Convergence Directive Committee and perform the role of liaison between the FIMEM and the COPIL (Directive Committee) of Convergences.

The objective of FIMEM in Convergences is to promote common ideas between the Freinet and Educação Nova movement that coincide with our principles of an emancipatory and active school.



BECA BENAIGES

The winning projects received the corresponding amounts for the publication of their results.

A new jury will be formed for the next edition of the scholarship, which will be launched soon. The AC members who will be in charge of the Beca Benaiges project are Juan Platero and Gláucia Ferreira.

The meeting was organized by REPEF (Red de Educadores e Investigadores en Educación Freinet/Brasil) and hosted by Escola Curumim, which celebrated its 45th anniversary.

In addition to the participation of Brazilian Frenetian educators from various regions of the country, colleagues from Chile participated in the meeting.

AC FIMEM AT THE 56th ICEM CONGRESS – UNIVERSITY OF NANTERRE, PARIS, FRANCE from 22nd to 25th of August

The general theme of the ICEM congress was: "Freinet Pedagogy to fight against domination."

Representatives of foreign movements were invited: members from African countries, members of REMFA and the organizing OC of RIDEF in Mexico. Unfortunately, members of the African movements encountered numerous visa problems and were unable to attend. The Boards of Directors of the FIMEM and the ICEM made representations to the competent ministries and embassies.

The AC participated in the Congress by presenting a workshop. This focused on the internationalist aspects of Freinet Pedagogy, in which a dialogue was promoted on the importance of intercultural experiences fostered by participation in an International Federation.
